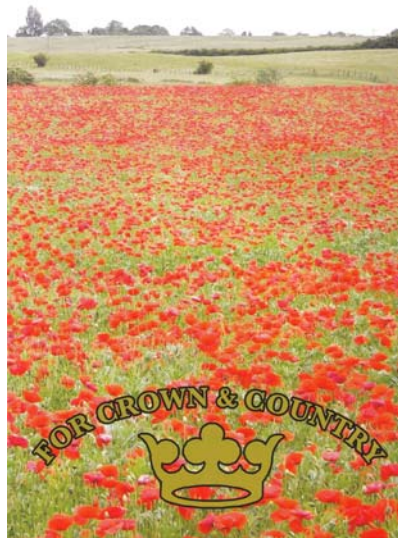


For Crown and Country
